

Summer Reading – 2008

Students will pick any book of their choosing to read this summer.

They are encouraged to pick a book that interests and challenges them.

Students: You will get out of this what you put into it!

Next fall, students will be responsible for proving to the English teachers that they have read and understood the book. They must create an artifact that discusses the following elements of literature:

- Characterization
- Plot
- Setting
- Theme

They may do this in a number of ways. They may choose any type of project they wish.

Examples may be:

- Story Board
- Powerpoint presentation
- Wikipedia page
- Essay
- Dramatic Monologue

Teachers will be available to answer questions via email throughout the summer.

Students are encouraged to read the same books as their peers so that they can discuss and collaborate on their learning.

The artifact will be graded pass or fail (100 or 0) and this grade will count toward their first English class. In the event that a student is not enrolled in an English class during the following school year, the grade will count in a history class.
